

Advance Notice of Road Closure

Dear resident

On Sunday 5 July 2026 the Withernsea 10k road race will take place in your vicinity.

Recent laws state that events on public highways can only take place on closed roads. To this end East Riding of Yorkshire Council have issued a Temporary Road Closure Order for the morning of the race. It will be in effect from 10:00am until 11:30am.

Roads closures will operate as a rolling road closure meaning that roads will be reopened once the race has passed.

Please see overleaf for the roads affected and estimated reopening times.

Also please note that emergency services will maintain access at all times.

Our stewards are only volunteers and they are there only to guide the runners safely around the route but are available to advise you when the road is likely to reopen.

If you can help to minimise any disruption by not attempting to use these roads during this time it will be greatly appreciated.

We regret and apologise for any inconvenience caused. Please be assured that we will be working hard to minimise any disruption.

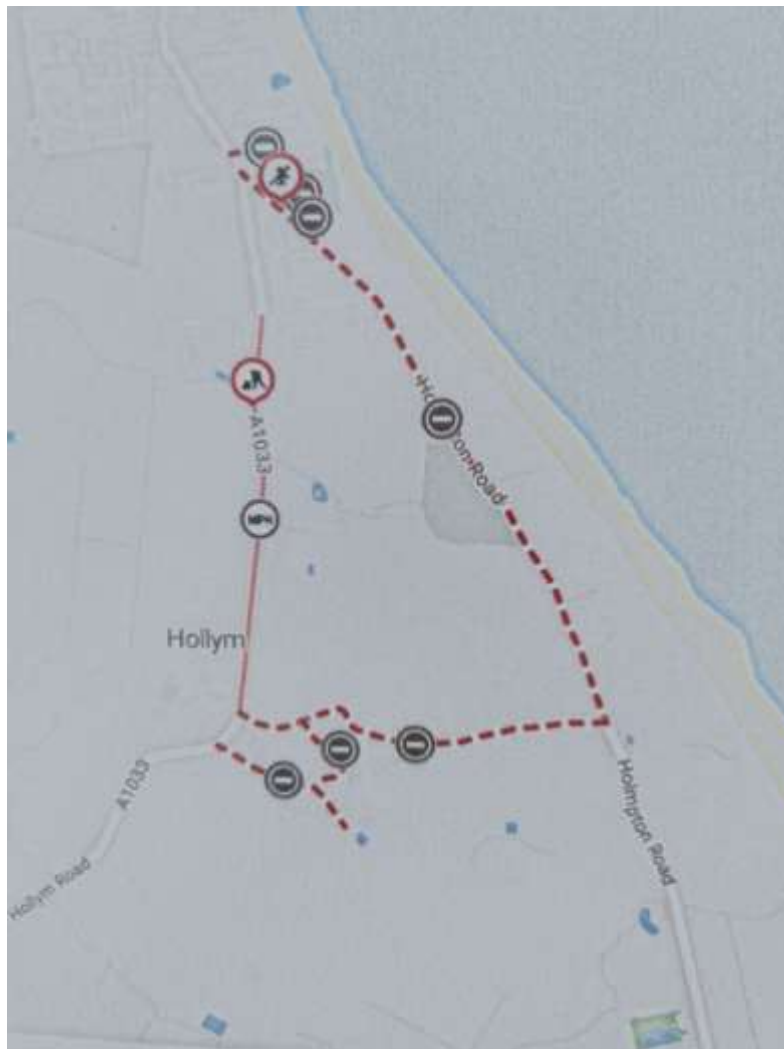

Roads impacted by the closures on 5 July 2026

Please remember that these are official road closures made by East Riding of Yorkshire council. Humberside police are aware and we are likely to be visited by representatives of either organisation to ensure that all regulations are being carried out.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Emergency services will have full access at all times.

Louville Avenue, Withernsea from South Promenade to the junction with Oak Avenue.

Oak Avenue, Withernsea for the full extent

Turner Avenue, Withernsea for the full extent

These roads will be closed from 10:00am until up to 11:30am for the outward and return legs of the race.

Holmpton Road, Withernsea from the junction with the A1033 to the junction with North Leys Rd, Hollym.

This will be closed in both directions from 10:00am. Diversions to and from Holmpton will be via Patrington.

It is anticipated that the outward leg of the race will be off the road by 10:30 and the road will be partially reopened. On their return to Withernsea, runners will be required to run on the footpaths alongside Holmpton Road. To enable a safe crossing point, the road will remain closed in both directions near to number 4, Holmpton Rd, Withernsea. However, to try to avoid unnecessary delays the road will be reopened for short periods to allow vehicles to proceed if the stewards see a large enough gap between runners.

North Leys Road, Hollym from the Garden Centre to the junction with Holmpton Road

Manor Lane for the full extent

South Leys Road, Hollym for the full extent

These roads will be closed in both directions from 10:00am. Diversions to and from Holmpton will be via Patrington.

It is anticipated that the race will have passed and the roads reopened by around 10:50
